



Prof. Nir London completed his PhD in computational structural biology at the Hebrew University in 2012. He then pursued a post-doctoral fellowship with Brian Shoichet at UCSF. In 2015 Dr. London joined the Weizmann Institute of Science. Dr. London's lab is focused on covalent chemical biology and is developing new technologies to discover and functionalize covalently acting compounds. His honors include amongst others, the 2021 EFMC award for young medicinal chemist in academia, the 2021 ISCB award for young chemical biologist, and an ERC consolidator award. He is currently the president of the Medicinal Chemistry Section of the Israel Chemical Society.
